CELL ART



Directions: For this activity you will choose an art movement/artist and use that particular style to create a painting, drawing, or sculpture of a cell (plant or animal). Your artwork must somehow incorporate the parts of the cell that we have discussed in class. If cell parts are not noticeable due to their unique incorporation into the artwork, you should be able to provide a reasonable interpretation of them. For this activity you will get two class periods to complete your artwork; thus, it is very important to complete a rough sketch of your ideas prior to starting. **You will not be allowed to start until a completed rough sketch is shown to me.** I will provide you with oak tag paper, brushes, and paints. Since many of you are talented artists, you may want to bring in some of your own personal supplies! To get you started, it may be beneficial to consider the information below.
